- > Comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and reporting as a minimum standard.
- > Prevent pollution and avoid or minimise adverse environmental impacts in all areas of the Company's operations.
- > Progressively rehabilitate areas of past disturbance in a responsible manner consistent with relevant regulatory requirements and appropriate industry practice.
- > Positively engage with all stakeholders, including Governments, local communities, employees, suppliers and regulatory authorities.
- > Maintain appropriate emergency response procedures and capability, including procedures for the notification of the relevant authorities in the event of any reportable environmental incident.
