To help inform this decision, the Agency is seeking comments from the public and Indigenous groups on the project and its potential effects on the environment, as described in the summary of the project description.

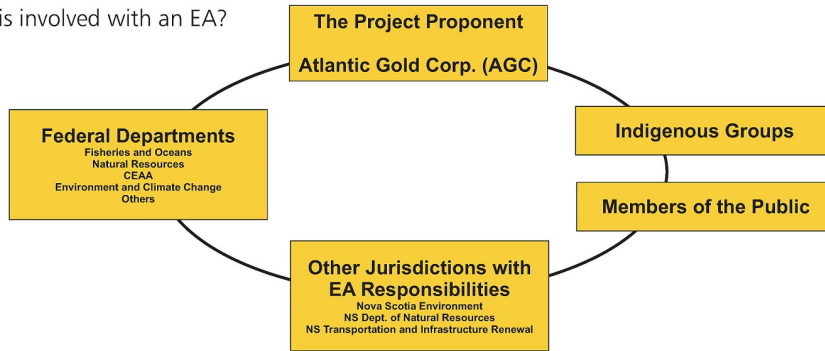

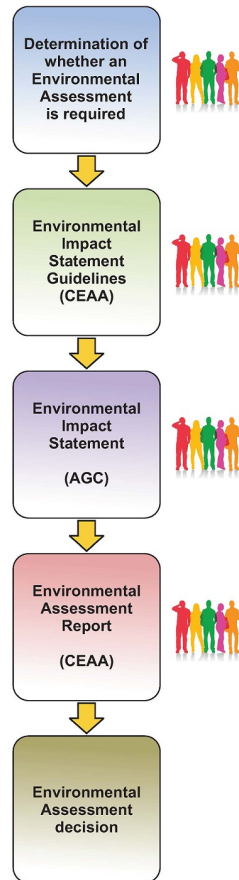

A few facts about the Fifteen Mile Stream Gold

- The planned start date for construction for the Project is May 2020 with a scheduled start-up for 2021.
- The mine will operate for a minimum of 6 years and will employ up to 200 persons including both salaried and hourly personnel.
- At the end of mining activities, the site will be reclaimed.
- Ore will be crushed and concentrated on site to produce a gold concentrate which will be hauled by on-road highway trucks to the Touquoy mine

Fifteen Mile Stream is located north of Sheet Harbour, off Highway 374.
