- AGC's Manager, Environment and Permitting provided a brief overview of the status of the Cochrane Hill project and the committee asked questions
- Project Description is expected to be submitted to CEAA in late August.

### 4. New Business

The Committee discussed how the meetings should run and suggested the following:

- Everyone should ask questions as they arise.
- Make sure everyone has an opportunity to speak. Share the air space.
- Keep responses on point and brief.
- Any issues/questions raised by the community will be shared with the committee, but personal information (such as names and addresses) will not.
- Meeting notes will be shared shortly after the meeting for the committee to review.
- Committee members are encouraged to talk about what you learned at this meeting with the public.

The CLC received an orientation that covered the following topics:

- Introductions of all in attendance
- Role of CLC
- Guidance on how to communicate information with the public and how to deal with media inquiries.
- A review of the draft Terms of Reference of the CLC
- A review of the regulatory process under the Canadian Environmental Approval Agency.
- A brief description of the location of the proposed mine
- An overview of questions that AGC has received from stakeholders and rights holders to date. The CLC provided additional questions that they either have heard asked or believe the community will ask. This included:
  - Questions regarding the safety measures from flying rocks from trucks
  - How AGC will deal with speeding trucks?
  - Questions regarding noise?
  - What will the final land use be after the mine closes?
  - Is there an opportunity to augment tourism activities through a view station of the active mine or other interpretative activities?
  - How will contractors be chosen and used?



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- Who owns the land after AGC is finished mining?
- Questions about light pollution?
- Questions about impact on wetlands and wetland compensation planning?
- Where is the start up water coming from?
- Questions about greenhouse gas emissions?
- Will AGC prepare a 3-D model of the site?
- How financially stable is AGC?

**ACTION ITEM:** The Community Relations and Land Management Consultant will coordinate with the Manager, Environment and Permitting to provide a tour of the mine to the CLC members.
