### **Meeting Notes**

#### 1) Approval of Previous Minutes

- Meeting minutes from the April 7, 2018 and July 7, 2018 meetings were provided to the Committee. Gilbert Fahie moved to approve April 7, 2018 minutes and Charlie Brown seconded
- Charlie Brown moved to approve, Barry Prest seconded approval of July 7, 2018 minutes. These minutes will be circulated to the AGC Communications Manager to post on the website.

#### 2) Business Arising from the Previous Minutes

- A copy of the presentation from the last CLC meeting was distributed to members - Action item is complete.
- The Committee discussed the refurbishment of Scraggy Lake dam.  
**ACTION ITEM:** Charlie Brown will compose a letter regarding Scraggy Lake dam refurbishment. The letter will be circulated to CLC members prior to submitting to NSE.

- The Committee discussed recruitment for the Fifteen Mile Stream (FMS) CLC. Atlantic Gold's Community Relations and Land Management Consultant is actively working on recruitment. The first meeting is scheduled for November. Gilbert Fahie and Barry Prest have volunteered to become members.  
**ACTION ITEM:** Community Relations and Land Management Consultant will reach out to Gilbert Fahie and Barry Prest regarding the FMS CLC  
**ACTION ITEM:** Community Relations and Land Management Consultant will reach out to potential new CLC member for Touquoy and/or FMS.
- The Committee discussed the water trapped along the main highway. Approval has been received to install a new culvert and the permit has been obtained.  
**ACTION ITEM:** Report progress at next CLC meeting
- The Committee discussed the naming of the roads. Road signs are now installed. Older signage will be removed.
- The Committee followed up on the installation of streetlights. AGC's Site Services department is investigating streetlights. An inspector arrived but did not inspect for streetlights.  
**ACTION ITEM:** Report progress at next CLC meeting
- The Committee discussed the status of the flashing lights and gate. The flashing lights have been installed at the entrance to the haul road. A gate will be installed on the road that currently leads to the pit, in the vicinity of the monument of the old church. There is a parking lot adjacent to the monument to allow the public to park and view the monument.
- The Committee discussed the AGC newsletter. The newsletter is currently circulated via email.  
**ACTION ITEM:** The CLC recommends the newsletters are posted on the AGC website
- The FOIPOP information was provided and this Action Item is complete.
- The format of the meeting minutes has been revised and the Action Item is complete.
- The Committee discussed the CLC meeting minutes on the AGC website. The minutes are posted but are difficult to locate.

### 3) Project Updates

#### a) Discussion of Beaver Dam

The Committee discussed formally accepting Beaver Dam into the Touquoy CLC. The Committee reviewed the CLC Terms of Reference. The Terms of Reference need to be altered to remove Cochrane Hill and Fifteen Mile Stream as the communities are too far removed.

**ACTION ITEM:** Amendment of Terms of Reference to strike Cochrane Hill and Fifteen Mile Stream from the Touquoy CLC to be sent to NSE. Charlie Brown put a motion on the floor to revise the Terms of Reference. Richard Deale seconded the motion.

The Committee received a presentation of the current status of Beaver Dam. The Project Description and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) were submitted in June 2017 and resulted in additional information requests. December is the deadline to resubmit the EIS and all additional information requested.

AGC asked if the Committee is aware of the current road use in the vicinity of Beaver Dam. A Committee member stated that sections of the road are used for lumber as well as ATVs, hunting and fishing use. A road management plan is required and input will be required from the CLC. The Committee discussed fire protection and location of current fire tower in the vicinity of Sheet Harbour.

### b) Touquoy Update

The Committee was provided an update of the Touquoy mine site operations. An Environmental update was also provided.

### 4) New Business

#### a) Mileage checks to be issued
